#### **ACTION ON EXECUTIVE SESSION**

**00-09-05** - Dr. Smith moved that the Board issue a Notice of Intent to Discipline, Revocation of Optometry License and Imposition of Civil Penalties, \$1,000 per violation pursuant to ORS 683.140 for examinations which fall below the standard of care pursuant to ORS 683.140(3) and OAR 852-10-028, incomplete patient records which fall below the requirements for Oregon optometric physicians pursuant to ORS 683.140(3) and OAR 852-10-051(1), billing for comprehensive examinations when comprehensive examinations were not performed in violation of ORS 683.140(4) and OAR 852-10-027(1), and failure to notify the Board and obtain a license for a practice location prior to commencing practice at the location pursuant to ORS 683.100 and OAR 852-50-016(1), failure to notify the Board that the licensee had ceased practicing at a location in violation of ORS 683.100 and OAR 852-50-016(1), and failure to maintain patient records for patients examined at the location as which the doctor no longer works or to transfer them to the care of another doctor of optometry in violation of OAR 852-19-051(2). Dr. Reslock seconded the motion.

There was a roll call vote taken. The vote was unanimous. The motion carried.

There was no other business to come before the Board.

The next meeting of the Board was set for February 2, 2001.
